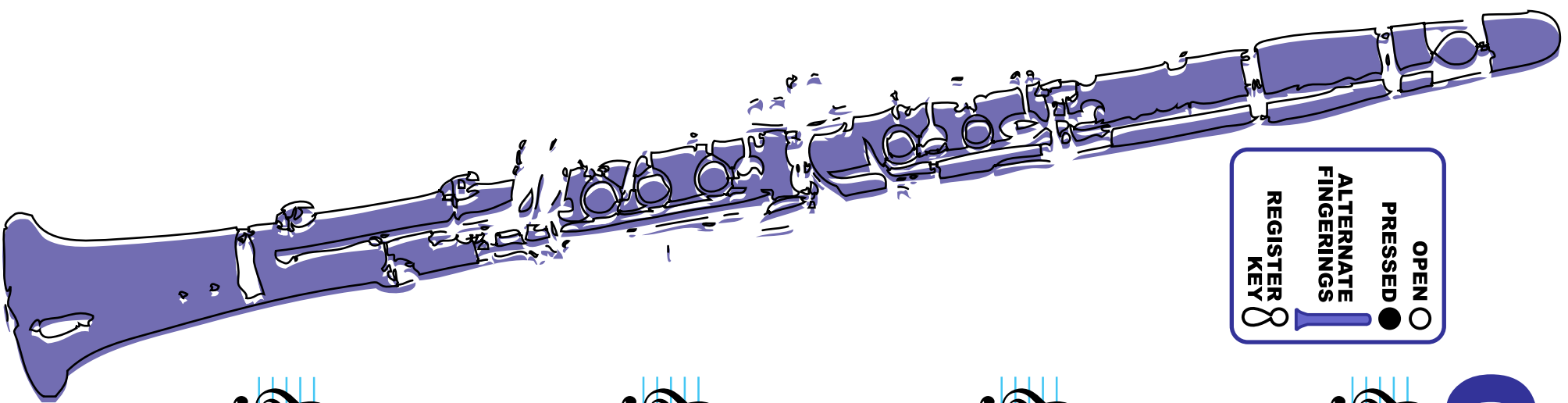


CLARINET FINGERINGS
